I. PREFACE

Hokkaido University Liaison Office in Indonesia (LO Hokudai) was established in June 2017 and located in IPB University, Gedung Pascasarjana Dramaga Campus R-200, Bogor 16680, West Java, Indonesia to provide information and services regarding Hokkaido University to Indonesian students and academic staff. The office opens every weekday (09.00 - 16.00) and closes on the weekends or Indonesian public holidays.

II. ACTIVITY IN HOKKAIDO UNIVERSITY LIAISON OFFICE IN INDONESIA

LO Hokudai provides information and assistances any inquiry regarding Hokkaido University. The information and assistance are including the international academic details such as research opportunities, summer school programs, student exchange programs, scholarship programs, and other related educational programs of Hokkaido University. As seen in Table 1, the activities at Liaison Office Hokkaido University in Indonesia mainly provided some information regarding Hokkaido University programs to visitors, supporting Hokudai University Collaboration program with alumni association and related international bodies in Hokkaido University and Indonesia Institutions, and performed administrative tasks. The information was published on the information board and LO Hokudai in Indonesia's Instagram account. Every activity follows the safety and health protocol recommended by the Ministry of the Health Republic of Indonesia during the pandemic of COVID-19. In April, Mei, and July, we held a webinar with Hokkaido University alumni entitled Sustainable Biofuel Program Session 1 and 2 and A Glimpse of Life in Hokkaido University. The webinar was presented through Zoom Meeting and Youtube to accommodate participants around Indonesia.

III. OPERATING HOURS

The daily operation of LO Hokudai is supported by volunteers consisting of a professor and students (graduate and undergraduate). The volunteer composition in LO Hokudai with each duty in helping the office from April 2021 – September 2021 is described in Table 2. Due to the completion of some volunteers' study period in IPB, some volunteers were settling their support to the office activity. The updated volunteer composition is shown in Table 3.




Figure 1 Volunteer Operating Hours in April-September 2021

IV. VISITORS OF LIAISON OFFICE

With the Enforcement of Restrictions on Community Activities which requires offices in non-essential sectors to implement 100 percent work from home (WFH), during July 2021 LO Hokudai office in Indonesia is unavailable for receiving visitors. However, the LO HU office has received visitors by following the applicable protocol from the end of July. The transformation of academic activities into online activities might contribute to the number of visitors during the pandemic.

In addition to visitors who come directly to LO HU, LO also receives visitors through their Instagram social media account. Visitors came with some questions regarding Hokkaido University programs, and most visitors were curious about scholarship opportunities at Hokkaido University. During August to September, visitors reached 639 accounts with 45.3% men and 54.7% women with various visitor locations, namely Jakarta, Bogor, Bekasi, Depok, and Bandung. The highest age range of social media visitors for LO HU is 25-34 years old.




Figure 2 Visitors of LO Hokudai during April - September 2021

V. WEBINAR: SUSTAINABLE BIOFUEL PROGRAM SESSION 1




Figure 5 Participant of Sustainable Biofuel Program Session 1 Diagram




Figure 7 Participant of Sustainable Biofuel Program Session 2 Diagram




Figure 9 Participant of Webinar: A Glimpse of Student Life in Hokkaido University Diagram
